<p>A YES vote would indicate the voter's preference for the establishment of a municipal utility that would solicit bids for and contract with a single private garbage hauler to provide residential curbside garbage, bulk waste and recycling pickup for all residential properties in the Township. The cost would be assessed by the Township to each residential unit through installment utility bills, pursuant to a duly adopted Ordinance. This service would eliminate the necessity of residential property owners and tenants having to contract with and pay for their own individual garbage pickup. A NO vote would indicate the voter's preference to maintain residential garbage pickup as it currently exists within the Township, with each owner and tenant individually contracting for their own garbage service with the provider of their choice.</p>

This amendment would give the veterans' property tax deduction to continuing care retirement communities on behalf of eligible veterans. The total amount of the deduction given to a continuing care retirement community would be based on the number of eligible veterans who live there. The community would be required to pass the value of the deduction on to each eligible veteran. Deductions would not be paid to continuing care retirement communities that are property tax-exempt. An eligible veteran who receives the value of a deduction through a continuing care retirement community cannot receive a veterans' property tax deduction on any other home he or she owns or in which a spouse lives. Eligible veterans must be New Jersey residents. They must have served in the military in time of war, or other emergency.
